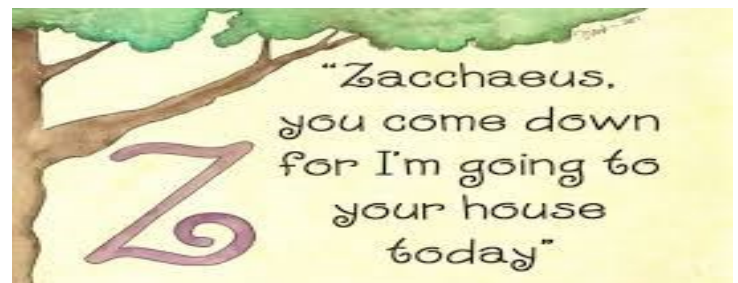


From the Administrator's Desk

Tellement semblable à tous et tellement semblable à chacun d'entre nous dans ses contrastes et ses tourments. Il est petit physiquement mais riche. Il est compromis dans les magouilles sociales, il est enfoncé de ses réussites ambiguës et sa réputation douteuse, mais en même temps il a une candeur, une curiosité, une naïveté et un désir d'enfant qui le rendent si sympathique.

Jésus passe sous l'arbre, aperçoit l'homme comme il nous perçoit maintenant, et crie ; « Descends ! » descends de ton personnage, descends de tes rôles, descends de tes peurs et de ton égoïsme, descends dans ton cœur pour y rejoindre Celui qui y habite depuis ton baptême ! Prendre le temps de descendre, c'est le premier pas de la conversion. Jésus ajoute simplement : « Aujourd'hui il faut que j'aille demeurer chez toi ».

Chez toi ? Cela veut dire tes propres contradictions, dans les difficultés de ta situation, dans tes désirs, dans tes échecs, dans tes candeurs et dans tes pesanteurs... c'est là que le Christ veut s'installer pour y apporter la liberté. « Le Fils de l'homme est venu chercher et sauver ce qui était perdu. »

Laissons Jésus venir chez nous. Pas seulement dans les parties les plus présentables de notre existence, dans la pièce la plus en ordre en cadenassant à double tour les chambres mal rangées dont on est moins fier. Jésus nous dit : il me faut demeurer chez toi, partout chez toi ; laisse-moi m'installer dans tes échecs, tes péchés, dans tes désirs d'enfance et tes naïvetés. Offre-toi face à moi avec tout ce que tu es. En m'acceptant partout chez toi, tu t'accepteras partout chez toi, tu deviendras homme. Tu seras fils de Dieu.

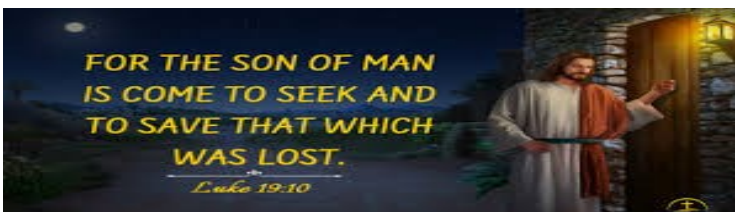
