WELCOME TO OUR WEEKLY PARISH BULLETIN! Being the administrator of two poor parishes makes me realize more how important money is in the endeavor to maintain our churches. The past weekend we launched the Saint Angela's annual fundraising. The funds collected will serve for the replacement of our church's carpet. We can't wait to see Saint Angela's carpet being replaced and both churches being renovated. All that can be done with money. This weekend's gospel can sound shocking and awkward as Jesus praises a dishonest steward who misused twice his master's money. Not only did that steward mess up the funds entrusted to him but he planned ahead to falsify the bills of his employer's customers in a way that would significantly lower their debts. Jesus praises that crooked steward not because of his awful dishonesty but because of his smartness in securing his future. The point is that Christ's disciples should also use all spiritual and material goods, money included, in order to secure for themselves a future livelihood in God's Kingdom. We know the saying: "money is a good servant, but a bad master." Sure, money is a good servant when we use it for our comfort, for making others happy, for serving the Church and the needy. But money is a bad master when it directs our thoughts, actions, and even our prayers, when we use it to expand our wealth and our pride, and to oppress others, as the Prophet Amos vigorously denounces it in our first reading. Jesus encourages us to make friends with the passing wealth so that, when it fails, we will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. May we always use what is passing for securing for ourselves a lasting future in heaven!

NOTRE-DAME DE LA SALETTE : Notre Dame de la Salette est le vocable sous lequel est appelée la Vierge Marie à l'occasion d'apparitions dans la commune de la Salette dans le département de l'Isère en France. La Vierge y serait apparue le 19 septembre 1846 à deux enfants, une bergère de quinze ans Mélanie Calvat et un jeune berger de onze ans Maximin Giraud. Tous deux virent dans une lumière resplendissante une 'belle dame' vêtue d'un costume étrange. Mélangeant français et patois, elle s'est plainte de l'impiété des chrétiens et les a avertis du danger qui les menace s'ils continuent dans le mal. Elle leur confie un message de conversion, pour "tout son peuple". L'émotion provoquée par le récit de Mélanie et de Maximin fut vive. Mgr Philibert de Bruillard, évêque de Grenoble, nomma une commission pour examiner l'événement de manière prudente; celle-ci conclut qu'il fallait admettre la réalité de l'apparition. Bientôt plusieurs guérisons miraculeuses survinrent sur la montagne de la Salette et les pèlerinages y commencèrent. La première pierre d'une grande église fut solennellement posée sur la montagne le 25 mai 1852. Cette église, plus tard promue au rang de basilique, fut desservie par des religieux appelés missionnaires de la Salette.
